## Terminology

- Short-term memory (STM)
- Long-term memory (LTM)
- Attentional subsystem
- Orienting subsystem

#### Mechanism

- Orchestrate the search for template matches
- Determine what constitutes a template mismatch

### Sequence of events

- The F<sub>2</sub> node that responds most strongly to the input *I* is active while all others are inactive.
- The F<sub>1</sub> gain control allows the input to be transmitted to F<sub>2</sub> under the 2/3 rule. The orienting subsystem is not active.
- If a match occurs then resonance takes place, otherwise F<sub>2</sub> is reset and new template is read out.
